The Extensive Reading Scheme is implemented in our school for cultivating students' reading interest, fostering an active reading habit, enriching students' knowledge and enhancing their Chinese and English reading and writing competence. As Chinese New Year is approaching, in order to encourage students to make a good use of the holidays for reading, F.3 students are required to read Chinese and English books and join our school's "Reading Award Scheme" and Hong Kong Education City (HKEdCity)'s "Reading Contract". Details are listed as follows:

Reading Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students are required to read self-selected Chinese and English books with no limit on the number and genre of books. • Students may refer to the recommended book lists of subjects and teachers' book recommendations.
Reading Reflections	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Write book reviews: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • at least one Chinese book review of at least 300 words and submit it to the Chinese subject teacher; • at least one English book review of at least 250 words and submit it to the English subject teacher. 2. Complete the Reading Record of the Reading Log Book. 3. Login to "My Reading Log" using the student account of HKEdCity and submit the aforesaid book reviews. "Best Performance Awards for Students" <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students who have submitted 5 or more reading records during the phase (February 1 to May 31, 2019) will be eligible for the award. • The "Best Performance Awards" will go to the student with the most reading records submitted. • If there is more than one student with the biggest number of reading records submitted, the winner will be determined by the content of the book reviews. • Awardees will each receive a \$100 gift voucher and a certificate. 2. Reading Badge <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • During the phase (February 1 to May 31, 2019), the students having submitted the number of reading records as stated below will receive electronic badges and electronic certificates (unlimited quota): Gold Reading Badge: submission of at least 15 reading records; Silver Reading Badge: submission of at least 10 reading records; Bronze Reading Badge: submission of at least 5 reading records.
