uBuddy Videoconferencing Programme (Phase 2)

The uBuddy Video-conferencing Programme (Phase 1), F.3 as well as F.4 and F.5 Special Programmes were held from October 2019 to March 2020 with the joint effort of the school and Legacy Pioneers. The Programmes aim at boosting students' self-learning skills, improving their English proficiency, enriching their understanding of different cultures and broadening their horizons. Participants responded positively to the programmes, especially in terms of enhancing their English communication abilities and skills.

In order to benefit more students and achieve the aim of “suspending classes without suspending learning” during the deferral of class resumption, our school will organize uBuddy Videoconferencing Programme (Phase 2) with Legacy Pioneers for F.1 to F.5 students. Four 50-minute group discussion sessions will be held from April to May 2020 on Saturdays and Sundays from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Participants will be arranged in groups of 4 to interact with native English speaking university students from America by using computers, tablets or mobile phones at any place with a Wi-Fi connection (e.g. at home). The programme fee is HK\$800. Upon completion of all four sessions, students will be refunded 50% of the programme fee, i.e. HK\$400, by the school.
